A Health Facilitator is a Learning Disability Nurse

Health Facilitators work with many services including:

Health Facilitators advise health care services on how to give better care to people with a learning disability.



They train doctors, nurses, dentists and others on the needs of people with learning disabilities.



They listen to people with learning disabilities and their carers about their experiences of health services.



They help doctors and nurses to understand how to complete Annual Health Checks for people with learning disabilities.



They make sure that services are making changes to how they work with people with learning disabilities. This is called making 'reasonable adjustments'.
