Overview

The Oxfordshire Training Network (OTN) in association with HTS training are delighted to offer Basic Life Support courses for practice staff and GP Locums. This training is provided on a flexible basis to allow practices the opportunity to sign up any practice staff that may have missed their in-house practice training or have just started new employment with the practice. Practices can sign up one or more delegates at a time.

Delegates will receive the following to assist in meeting your annual CPD requirements:

- A training summary sheet, containing aims, objectives and outcomes, with a section for your feedback and reflections
- A certificate confirming 2 hours of CPR training, which contributes towards a verifiable CPD requirement.

Course Options

2 hour Basic CPR course (£72 inc VAT)

This course will comprise instruction in Basic Life support in accordance with Resuscitation Council (UK) guidelines.

This will include:

- Basic CPR for adults, children and infants
- Use of AED
- Choking
- Care of an Unconscious casualty (recovery position)

All candidates will have ample opportunity to practise on manikins and AED training devices. This will be suitable for all members of the Practice team, clinical and non-clinical staff.
