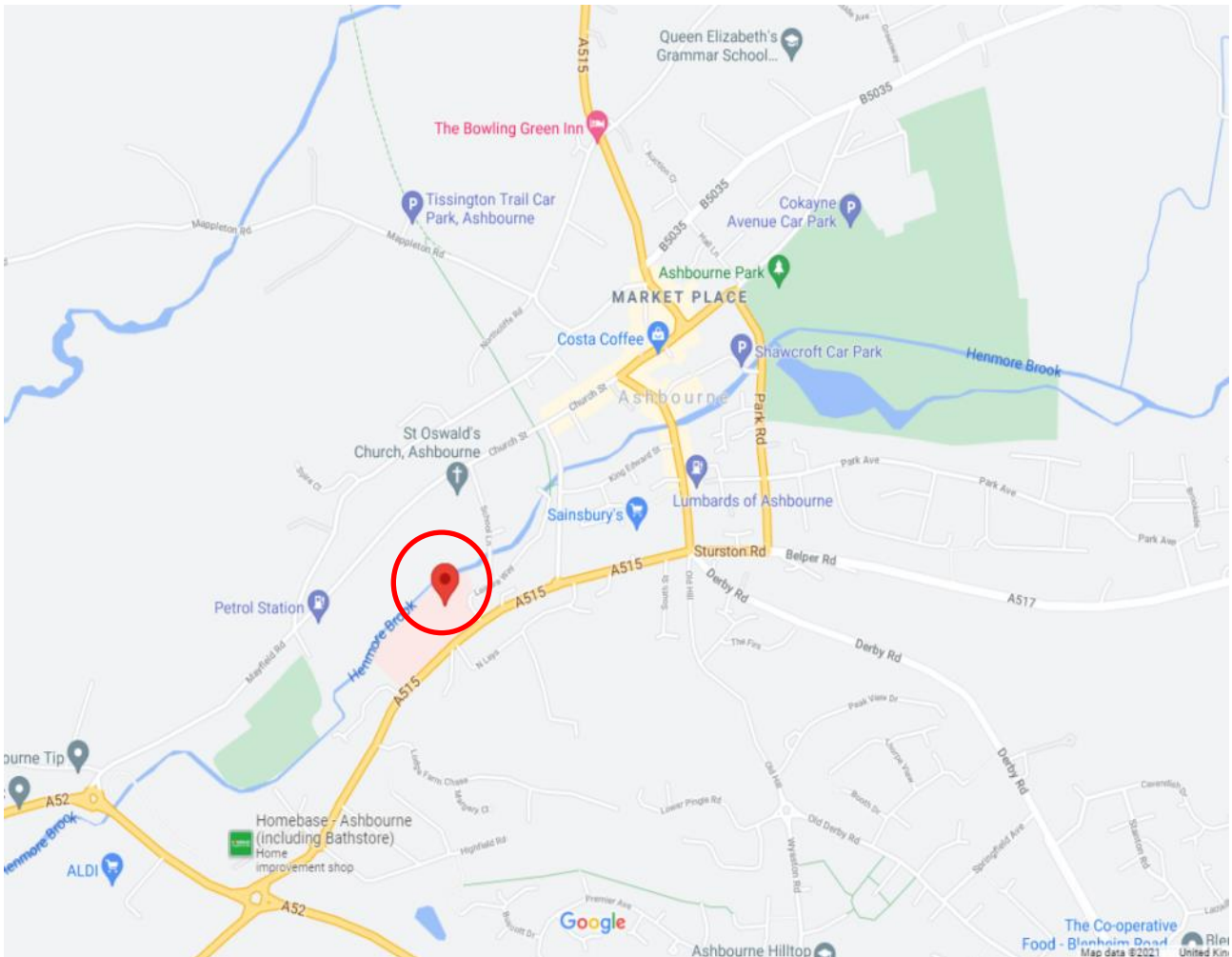
Ashbourne Medical Practice

The practice is situated in Derbyshire Dales and is an established dispensing general practice five-GP partnership delivering general medical services (GMS contract) caring for people living in Ashbourne and surrounding areas. The practice operates from a purpose built premises which are attached to St Oswald's Hospital, in Ashbourne. The practice is a well established teaching practice of both GP registrars and medical students and is supported by a strong clinical and non-clinical workforce. The mission of the practice is to deliver high standards of patient care whilst working towards the GPFV plan and supporting the NHS to deliver a sustainable system.

The current list size is 9300 and growing due to new housing developments within the current boundary area. The demographics of the practice population are broadly similar to national statistics with a slight excess in frail elderly patients. The practice serves a rural and town population which includes a large farming community in the surrounding smaller villages. There are areas of deprivation and substance misuse is generally a minor issue. The practice also provides medical care to two nursing and one residential care home.

The practice is part of the Derbyshire Dales Primary Care Network serving a population of 80,000 with a more local South Dales Hub consisting of 4 local practices; this is developing into a neighborhood within the larger PCN to secure more local funding and collaborative working across the South Dales region. The practice is actively participating and collaborating in this progressive approach to primary care. In February 2019 the Care Quality Commission rated the practice as good.

The practice is located approximately 13 miles from Derby, 30 miles from Nottingham, 15 miles from Leek and 30 miles from Stoke on Trent. There are a number of excellent local primary and secondary schools in the area with local high quality housing developments amongst an attractive rural environment. Ashbourne is the 'Gateway to the Peak District' offering a range of independent and larger shops and recreation facilities.
