## Quality Improvement Activity - Further Guidance

 CLOSE

For the purposes of revalidation, you will have to demonstrate that you regularly participate in activities that review and evaluate the quality of your work.

Quality improvement activities should be robust, systematic and relevant to your work. They should include an element of evaluation and action, and where possible, demonstrate an outcome or change.

At each appraisal you need to demonstrate that you are engaged in quality improvement activities and provide supporting information for this.

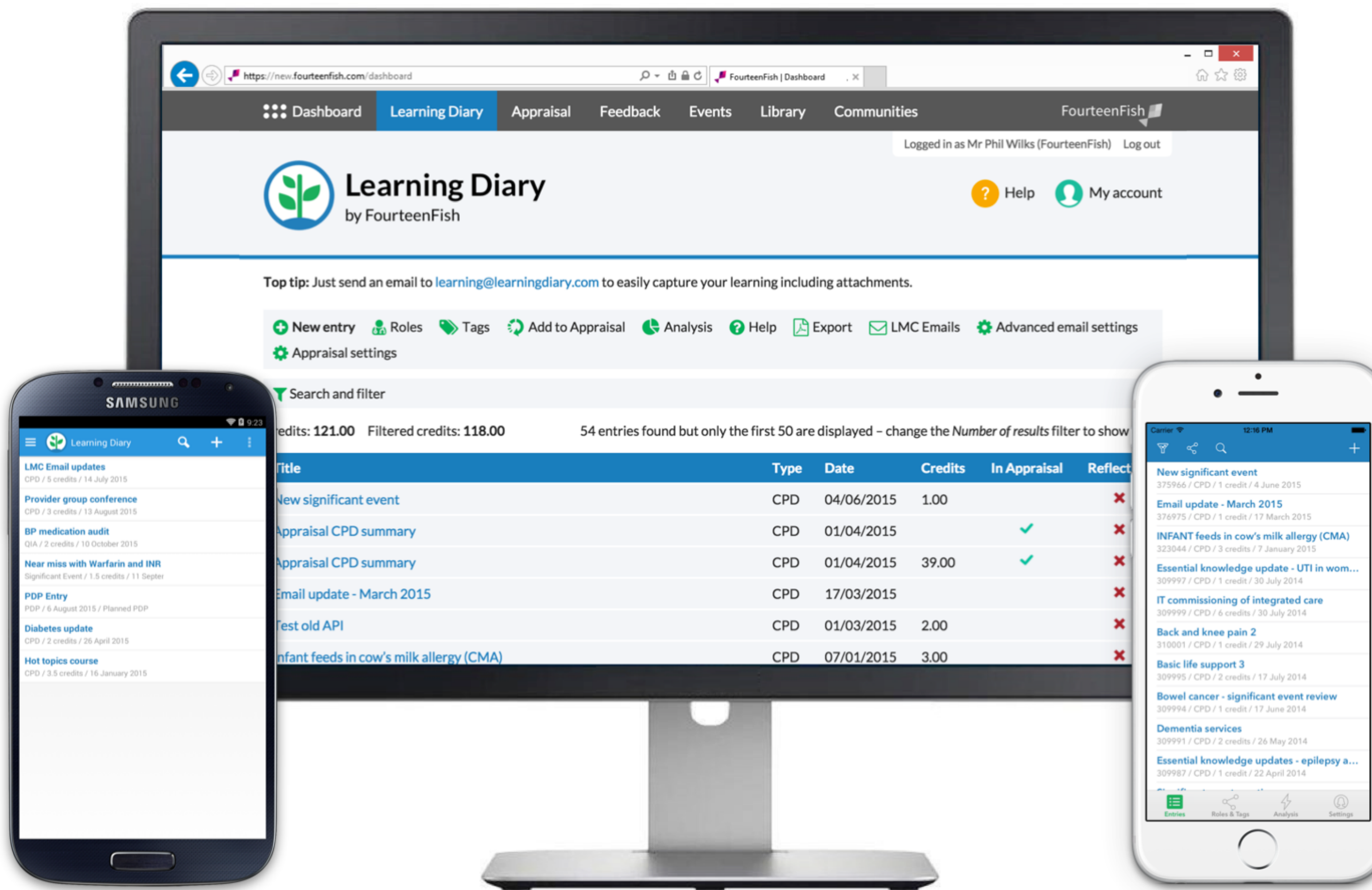
Examples of quality improvement are:

- Case based discussion
- Significant event reviews (as defined in QoF)
- A review of clinical outcome
- Audit and monitor
- Clinical audit
- PUNs and DENs

**Case review or discussion:** This should be a documented account of interesting or challenging cases that a doctor has discussed with a peer, another specialist or within a multi-disciplinary team. You must record an outcome. This may only be a single line but it needs to
